Topic: **Where Are They?**

Dear Humanitarian Workers,

Welcome to this week's **Inside ~ Outside Talks 2012** work session topic "**Where Are They?**" This is a very important question and work session regarding the "**Health**" of our relations and society conditions overall. It relates to a review of the community willingness to address and support issues that they have been working on for years. As well as new comers efforts to address the problems and the community's willingness to listen to new ideas on possible solutions for maintaining a good state for its needs.

Here in New York the answer to the question "**Where are they?**" Is~ **They are protesting.** Protesting in Union Park. Protesting about Wall Street. And protesting in other parts of New York City.

They are protesting and demanding that the NYPD commissioner Ray Kelly resign. The Occupy Wall Street protesters are demanding they be heard and that they be respected.

It is not good for New York's politicians to have them protesting right now but the management of New York does need to hear what is on the minds of the protesters and the general public.

The politicians of New York are public servants and have responsibilities to the citizens of the city, state, and country. The management of New York City needs to understand how much commissioner Ray Kelly is costing our society over the issue of him resigning (who really has overstayed his term i.e. Mayor Bloomberg's position on two term limits:

Right now we need a new approach to the major problems in New York regarding education, police brutality, and the excessive amount of guns in the communities. There is a need to reestablish what is important along with the importance of respecting the laws.

Some of New York's management should understand the importance of Cleaning up the Hudson River. Having the containers built is very important for reconnecting to basic issues of what we should really care for and what we should valued by the general public.

In case some people still do not understand what we want as the before and after holding containers as support efforts for cleaning up the Hudson River are as follows:

1. The objectives of the **before** and **after** holding containers are to hold some of the water from the Hudson River. One container will be a dispensing container for various praying communities to get samples of the water from to take home or for their temples to pray for the water.

Filter the water, prayer for it, take pictures and show the results

on the Internet and return the clean water to another holding container in the same area so the public can see the efforts taking place for cleaning up the Hudson River.

It is preferred that referencing "**The Hidden Messages of Water**" by **Masaru Emoto** is referred to while working on the efforts of getting the sample water from the Hudson River cleaned. This will sever as a basic common platform for various discussions related to the attitudes of water and said results.

2. For about 200 small boats to be outfitted with pumps and filtering apparatus to get an ideal on how long it may take to clean up certain areas of the Hudson River (issues of divider sheets can be discussed in the future if forwarded).

If detailed designs of **before** and **after** holding tanks are needed kindly advise so arrangements can be made to do so.

The other very important issue regarding the question of "**Where Are They?**" is related to the issues of the Internet.

Most recently we have been discussing some of the problems we have been experiencing with the netbook. I been using in various locations in the New York City area. Besides coming to Riverbank State Park in the mornings, I also do work from the various libraries in mainly Manhattan, Lower East Side (LES), Chinatown and occasionally the library on 125th Street.

We phoned AT&T in regards to the networking problems in the Harlem area as well as discussing various security issues with several New York Public Library staff members.

Most recently Federal agents arrested some people in the Lower East Side area. It seems they violated and damaged several agencies websites and information.

For years several of us has advised that there are severe problems with the infrastructure of the Internet that needs to be corrected.

They should stop wasting time and fix the problems within the industry so that proper security does exist.

At this time, enough material has been covered for the support efforts of cleaning u the Hudson River and now it is up the various agencies to decide if they are going to support said efforts.

We would appreciate a prompt response for the request of the **Before** and **After** holding containers to be built quickly for many reasons.

Lastly, it seems that president Obama has decided to voice his opinion in regards to the shooting of Trayvon Martin in Florida.
